6. ①Reduce ②Reuse ③Recycle

3R indicates the initial letters of the 3 words. The order is important.

8. 1st Reduce

- Bring your shopping bags.
- Avoid excess packaging.
- Buy refillable products.
- Drain garbage well.
- Make a plan when do shopping.

9. 2nd Reuse

- When broken, fix and reuse.
- Buy products in returnable containers.

10. 3rd Recycle

- Separate garbage strictly.
- Utilize recycling collections in the local community.
- Utilize spot collections at supermarkets, etc.
- Buy recycled products.

12. Burnable Garbage Twice a week□□

◎“Moeru gomi (burnable garbage)” sticker is required.

◎You need to put one “Moeru gomi (burnable garbage)” sticker for a 30 liter garbage bag and two for a 45 liter garbage bag.

◎You can put in a plastics bag items you don't want others to see such as sanitary napkins and diapers, etc. and then put the bag in a garbage bag.

13. Raw garbage

●Kitchen refuse

●Leftover meals

Drain raw garbage thoroughly!

14. Parer scraps

Take the waste of paper, cardboard, wrapping paper and etc. on the day of recyclable waste (old papers) please.

◎An "Unburnable Garbage/Large Garbage" sticker is required.

◎Stick an "Unburnable Garbage/Large Garbage" sticker to a 30-liter or 45-liter recommended garbage bag.

◎If your waste item is so large that you cannot put it into a recommended garbage bag, stick one sticker to each waste item.

27. ※A different vehicle collects metal garbage in the range of unburnable/large-sized garbage separately after collecting usual unburnable/large-sized garbage.

We can collect large amount of waste that results from a move or re-arranging a house for a fee..

Please contact the Public Hygiene Division at least 4 days (excluding Saturday, Sunday and national holidays) prior to the desired collection date.

●Collection day: from Monday to Saturday mornings

※Please bring it out to the location where collection vehicle can park right next to it.

38. Subsidy Grant Program for Resource Recovery Activities

The city makes grants to an organization such as a neighborhood community association that collects old paper, old cloth, and metals.

Please bring newspaper, magazines, box cardboard, old clothes, aluminum cans, etc. to a group resource collection.

39. Dead animals

●Domestic dogs, cats, etc.

57. ☉Can, glass bottles and small metals can be put into one recommended garbage bag.

- ☉Separately strap newspaper, magazines, cardboard and cartons crosswise before putting them out.
- ☉Large size paper should be bundled with string and small paper should be in a paper bag and be bundled with string in the shape of a cross to prevent scattering.

58. Recycling of home electronics

- Ask a home appliances retailer to take away the unneeded one.
- The shop where you purchased the appliance and where you are going to buy the replacement are obliged to collect the appliances.
- You need to pay recycling fee as listed below and collection/transportation fee.

60. "Mottai-nai Ichi" (Too good to waste Market) is held!!

- We hold "Mottai-nai Ichi" to reuse collected ceramic and glassware.
- If you find what you like, you can take it home for free.
We also collect unneeded ceramic and glassware at the same site.
- The date and time for "Mottai-nai Ichi" will be notified in the city newsletter and at the web site.
※ Aside from "Mottai-nai Ichi", even damaged ware are not simply thrown away but are recycled as material for dishes, plates, etc.

61. We collect children's clothes, shoes and hats!!

We collect children's clothes, shoes and hats in our city. Bring them directly to the collection point written below.

62. We hold an event called "Guru-guru Marché" (Round and round Marché)

- We hold an event called "Guru-guru Marché" to distribute the collected children's clothes, etc. for free.
- If you find children's clothes you like or need, you can take them home for free.
We also accept and collect children's clothes at the site of "Guru-guru Marché".
- Information for its date, time and venue are notified in the city's newsletter or on its web site.

63. Recycling personal computer (PC)

- Personal computers are collected and recycled by manufactures. Please ask the manufacturer of your computer for procedures for collection and recycling fees.
- If the manufacturers fold up or home-built PC, please inquire (Ippan Shadanhoujin Pasokon 3R Suishinkyukai)

- There is no collection service by the city but you can bring them (main part only) to the resource-sorting workshop (refer to below)
