© "Moeru gomi (burnable garbage)" sticker is required.

◎You need to put one “Moeru gomi (burnable garbage)” sticker for a 30 liter garbage bag and two for a 45 liter garbage bag.

◎Garbage that you don't want others to see, such as sanitary pads and dippers, etc. can be wrapped with paper, etc. and put in a recommended garbage bag.

Drain raw garbage thoroughly!

Wrap up broken glass and others in paper and write contents on the outside.
