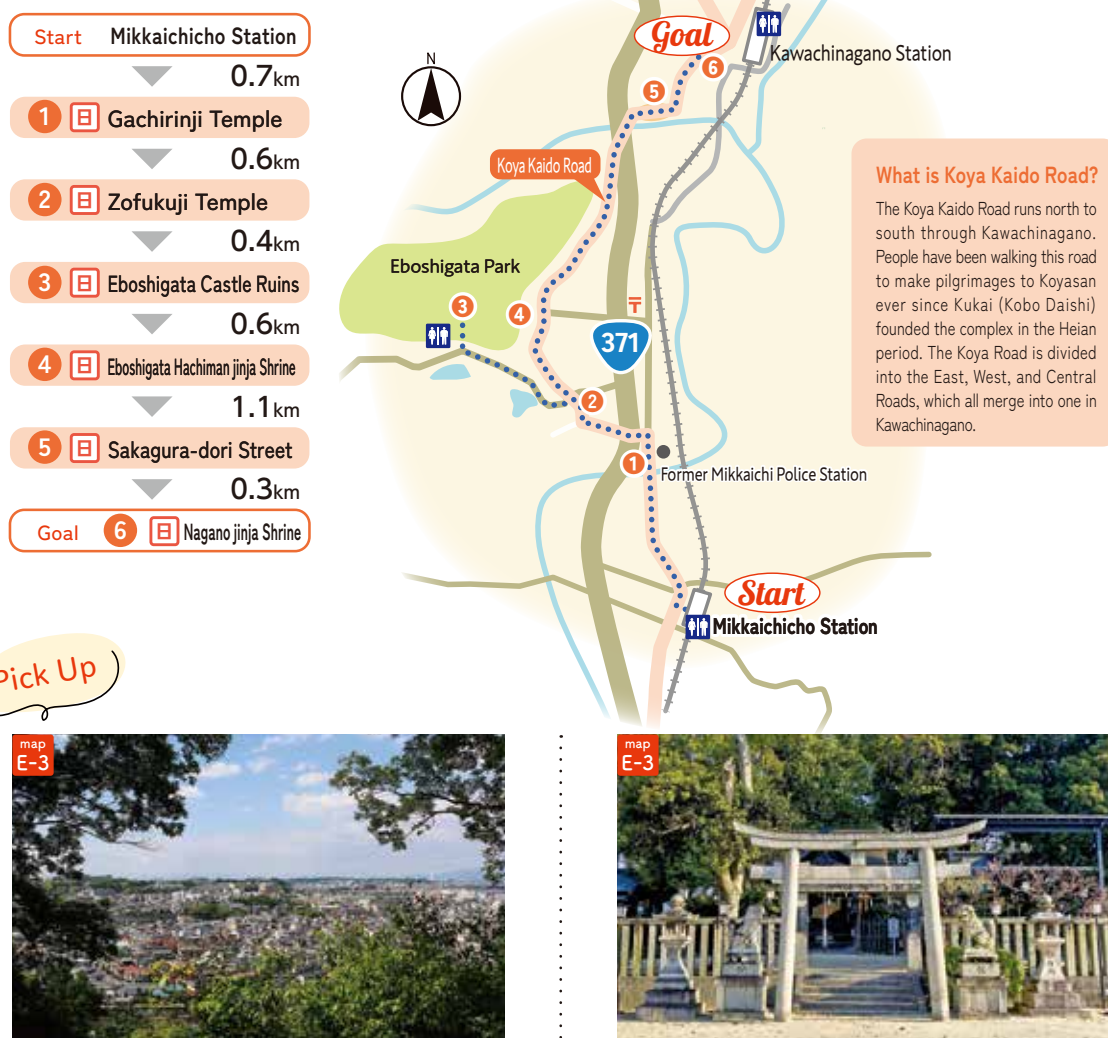

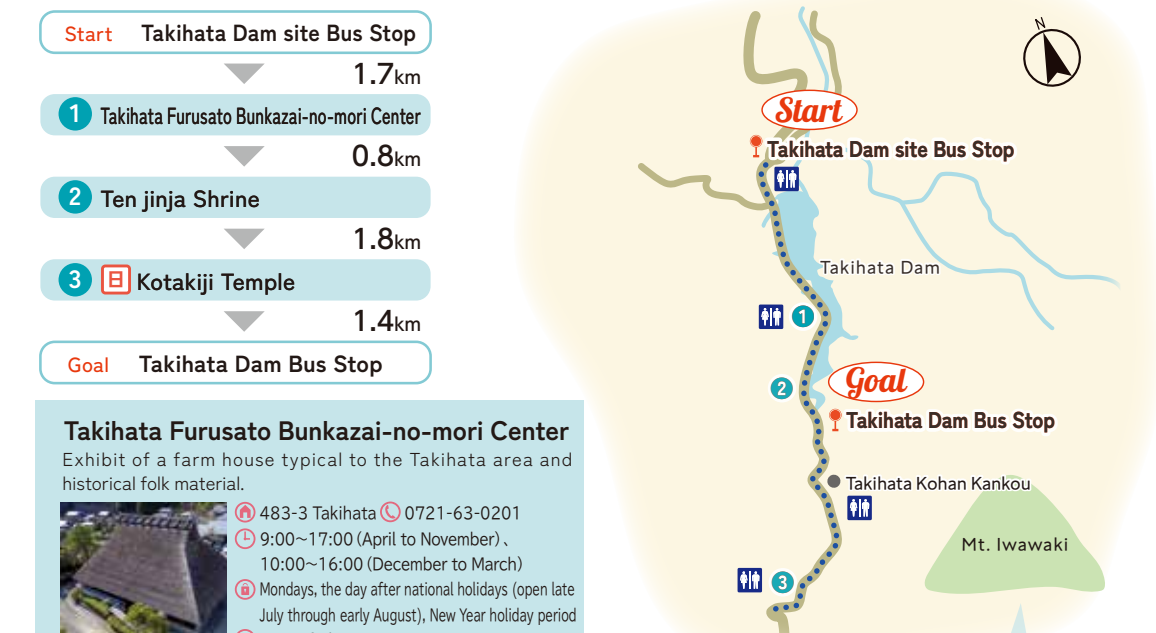

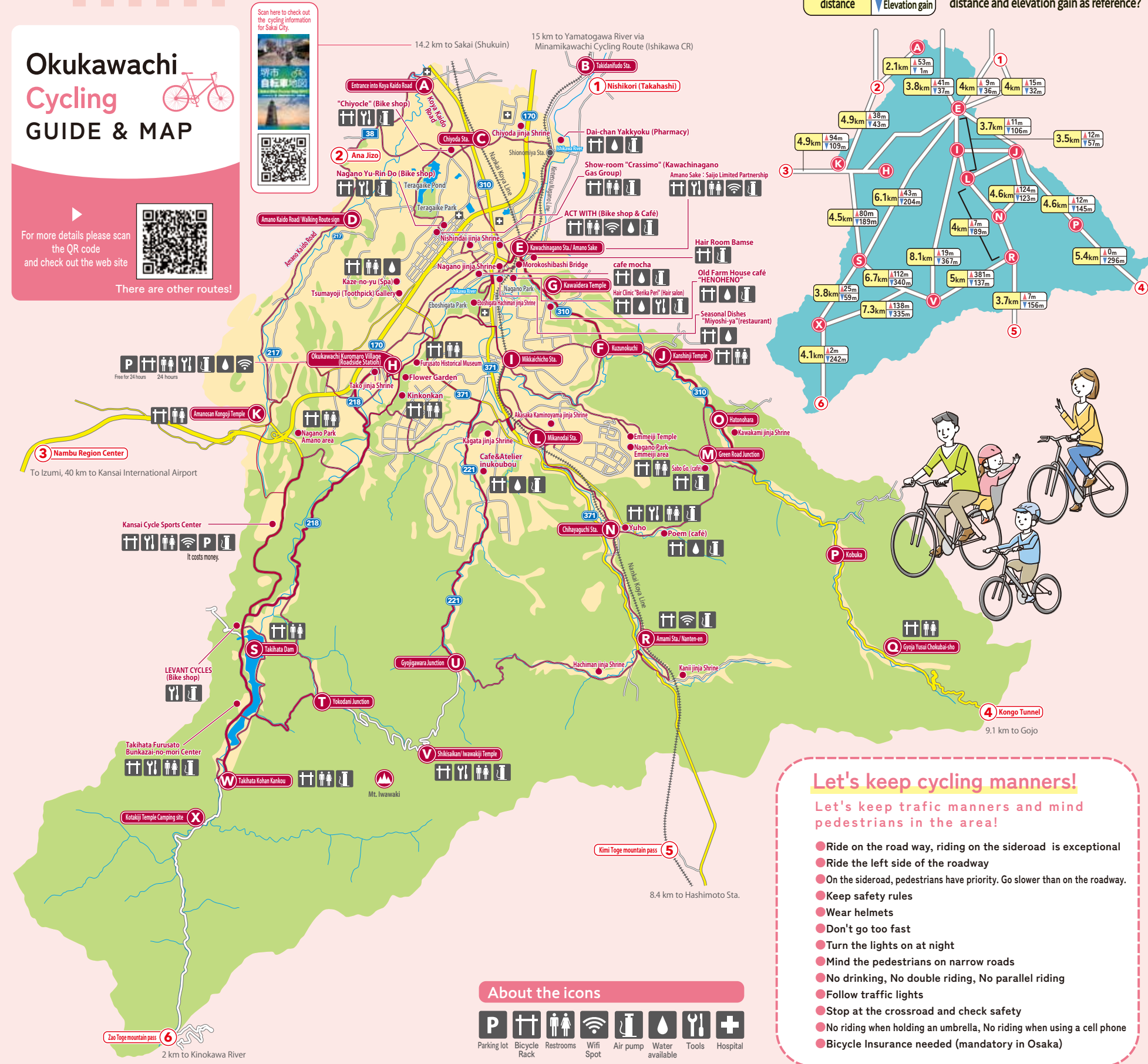
Furusato Historical Museum

Kansai Cycle Sports Center
One of the few bicycle theme parks which has about 800 unusual bikes and attractions that you play by pedalling. There is a a campsite (booking required) next to it where you can enjoy one day BBO or stay overnight.

Takahata Kohan Kankou
There are a restaurant and shops on the ground and also you can enjoy BBQ at the riverside. There are two camp sites in the vicinity and you can fully enjoy the abundant nature.

01 Closed-Train Track Route

[Recommended Points]
There are good sightseeing points known to those in the know, such as barriers made from scrap wood of the closed track. You can enjoy seasonal views; cherry blossoms in spring, bright green in summer, autumn leaves in fall, and snow in winter.

Course
① Kawachinagano Sta./Amano Sake → Koya Kaido Road → ② Mikkaichicho Sta. → ③ Mikanodai Sta. → Closed Train Track → ④ Chihayaguchi Sta. → Yuho → Minami-kawachi Green Road → ⑤ Green Road Junction → Kanshinji Temple → ⑥ Kuzunokuchi → ⑦ Mikkaichicho Sta. → Koya Kaido Road → ⑧ Kawachinagano Sta./Amano Sake

02 Takahata Dam Tour Course

[Recommended Points]
Start from Okukawachi Kuromaro Village, go across the countryside and bright green-covered scenery, and you will reach the Takahata Dam, which is the largest in Osaka Prefecture. It's also recommended to visit Furusato Bunkazai-no-mori Center or bike a little further to go see the 48 falls of Takahata.

Course
① Okukawachi Kuromaro Village → ② Takahata Dam → ③ Okukawachi Kuromaro Village

03 All Kawachinagano Golden Course

[Recommended Points]
It's the course you can visit most of the main sightseeing points and enjoy abundant nature. On the forest road, you can go through a unique loop tunnel. When you send out Japanese Sake as a souvenir at Amanosake Brewery, only a short length is left to reach the goal.

① Okukawachi Kuromaro Village → Nankaidai → Kagata → ② Gyojigawara Junction → Nagaredani → Hachiman Jinja Shrine → ③ Amami Sta./Nanten-en → Kani Jinja Shrine → Closed Train Track → ④ Chihayaguchi Sta. → Yuho → ⑤ Mikkaichicho Sta. → Koya Kaido Road → Eboshigata Hachiman Jinja Shrine → ⑥ Kawachinagano Sta./Amano Sake → Tsunayogi (Tootpick) Gallery → ⑦ Okukawachi Kuromaro Village
