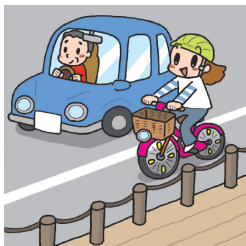

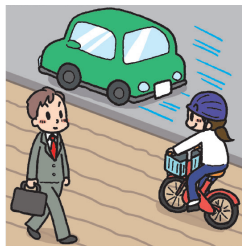


Let's follow bicycle traffic rules

As a rule, bicycles must travel on the road. Use sidewalks only in exceptional cases.



If the road has a designated sidewalk, bicycles must travel on the left side of the road, as a rule.



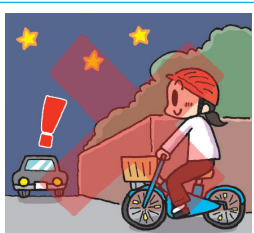
On a sidewalk, give pedestrians the right of way. Travel close to the right edge at a speed at which you can stop immediately.

Cases when you can travel on the sidewalk

- When there is a "Cyclists Permitted" or similar signpost on the sidewalk
- When the rider is a child under 13 years of age, a senior citizen over 70 years of age, or is physically disabled
- When the roadway cannot be traveled safely, due to ongoing road work, a parked car or heavy traffic, etc.

Enroll in bicycle liability insurance

People riding bicycles in Osaka Prefecture must enroll in bicycle liability insurance, etc.

[Example of high compensations]

An elementary school child collided head-on with a female pedestrian while riding a bicycle home. The woman suffered a skull fracture and other injuries, and has been unconscious ever since the accident. The child's guardian was found liable for supervision and ordered to pay damages.
