

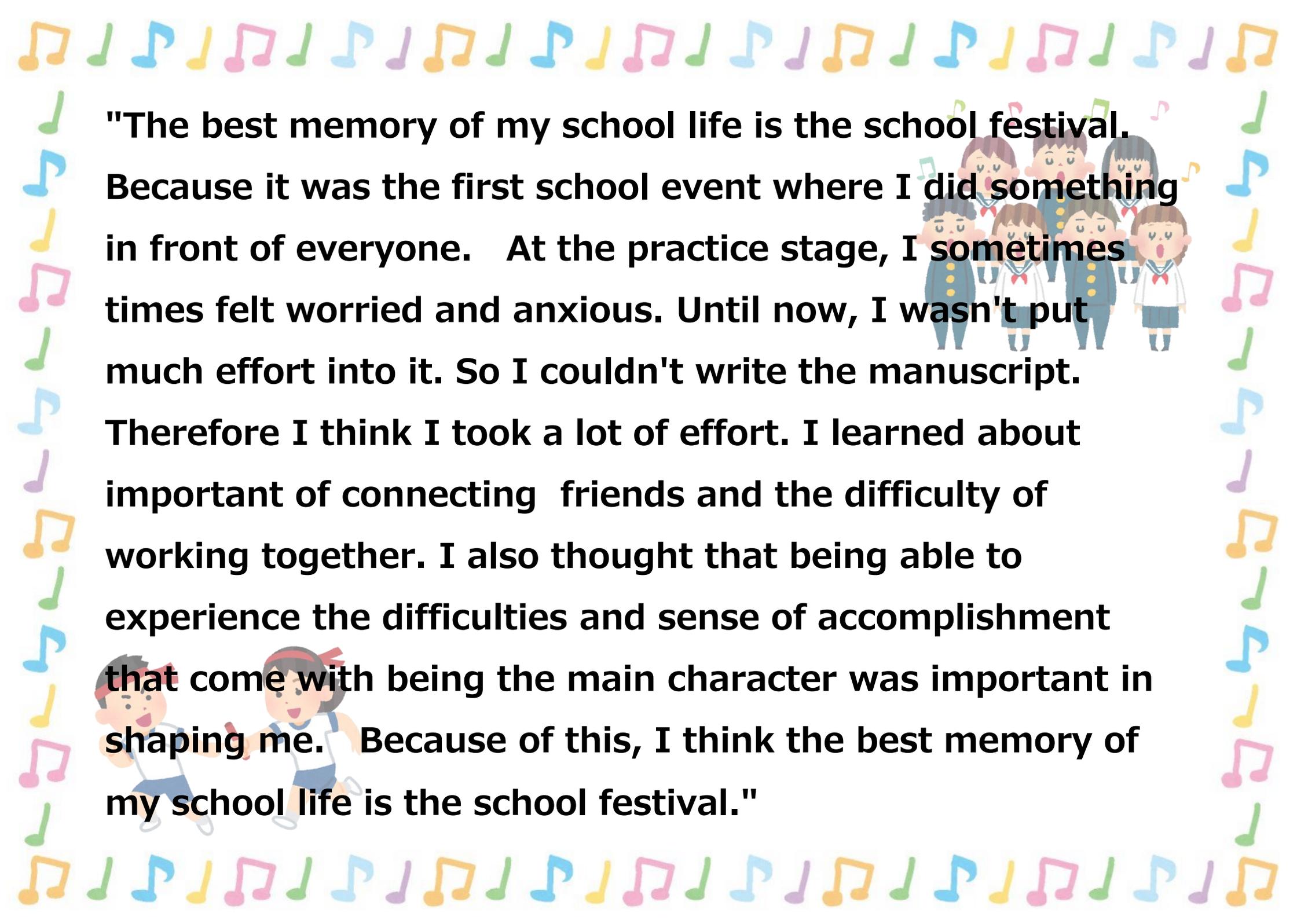
"I went on a school trip to Nagasaki. I got on the bus.

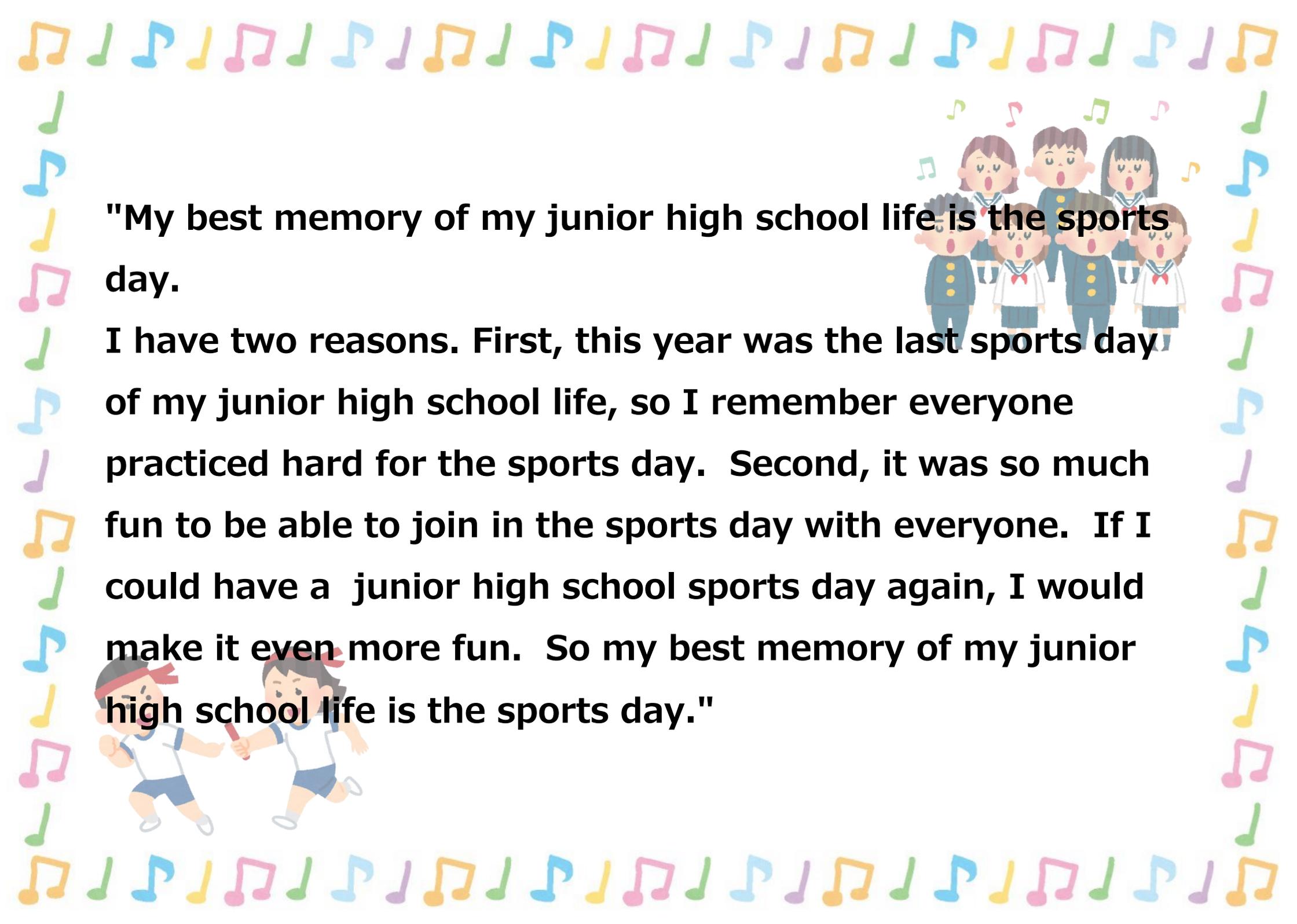

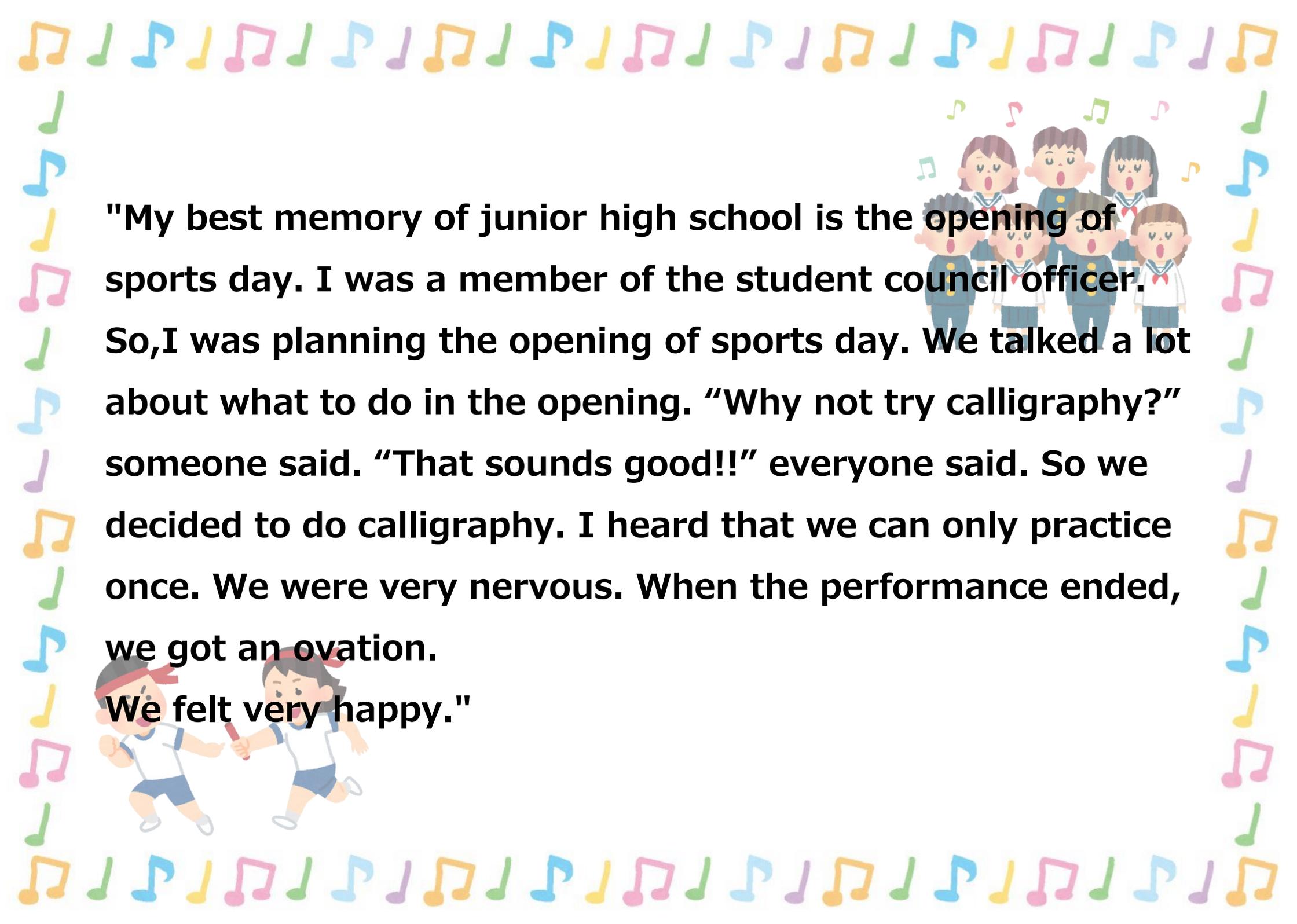
I went Chinatown. I ate Kakuniman there. It was very delicious.

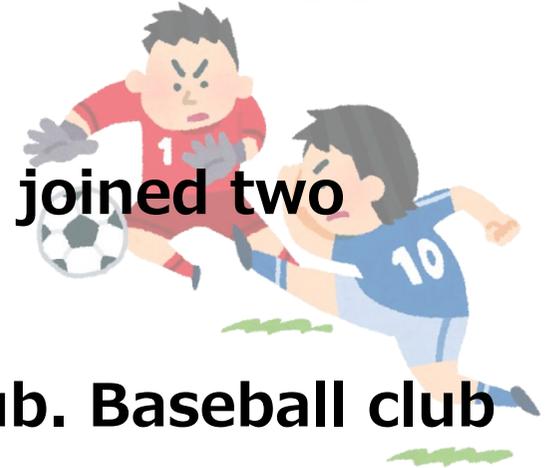

These three years were very busy because I joined two club.



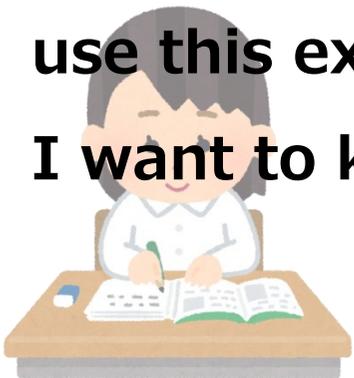

It was a very memorable school trip."



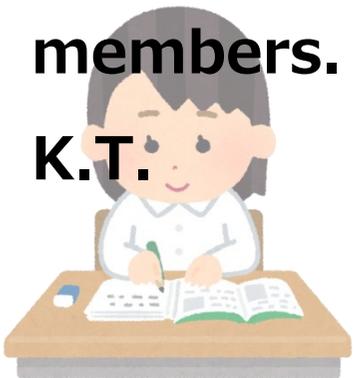

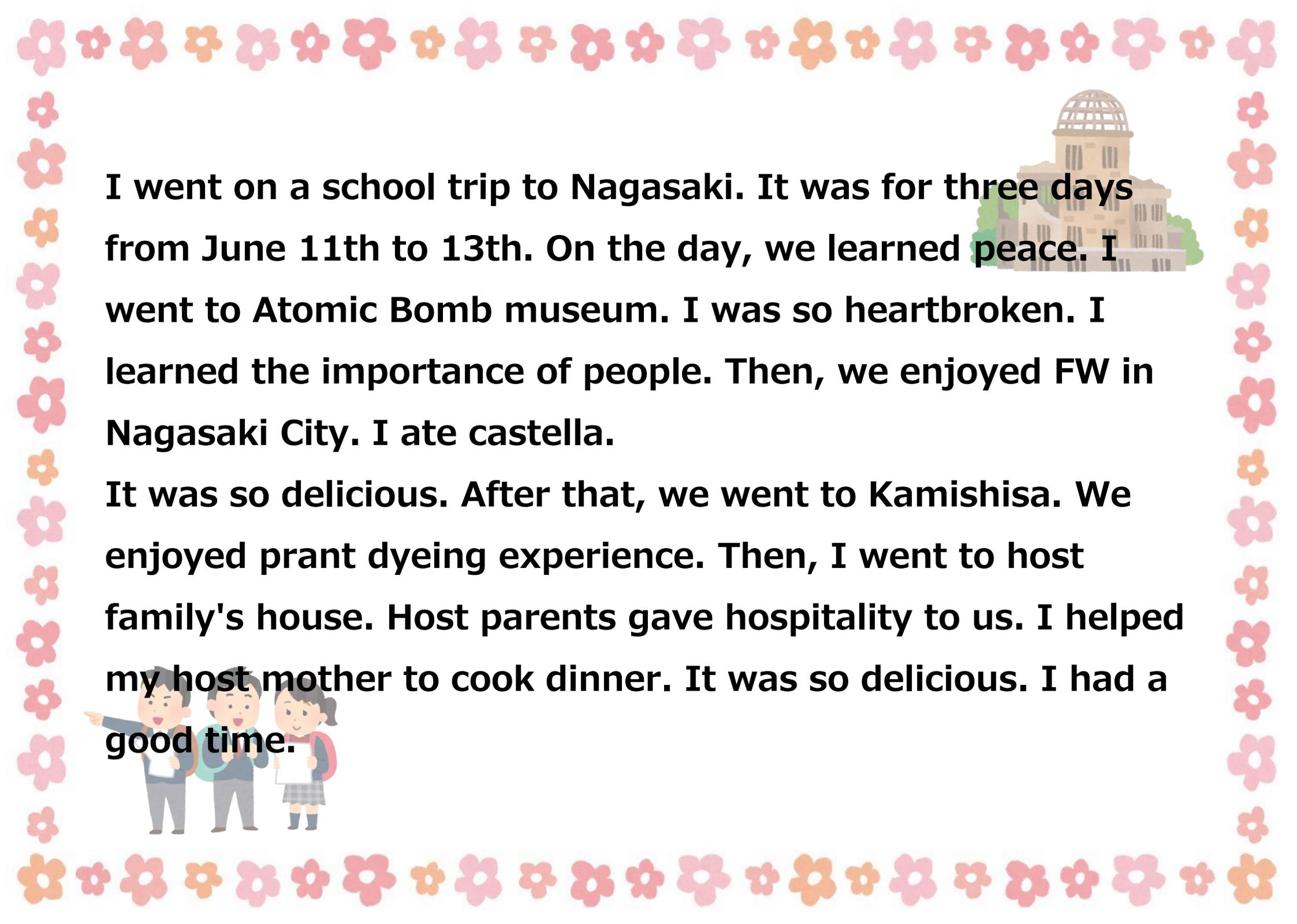
That day was my birthday. It was a lot of fun and I had a very good time. "

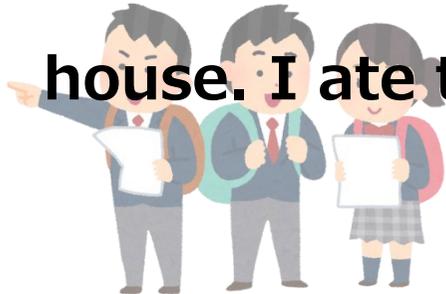

very kind. It was a very fun school trip."

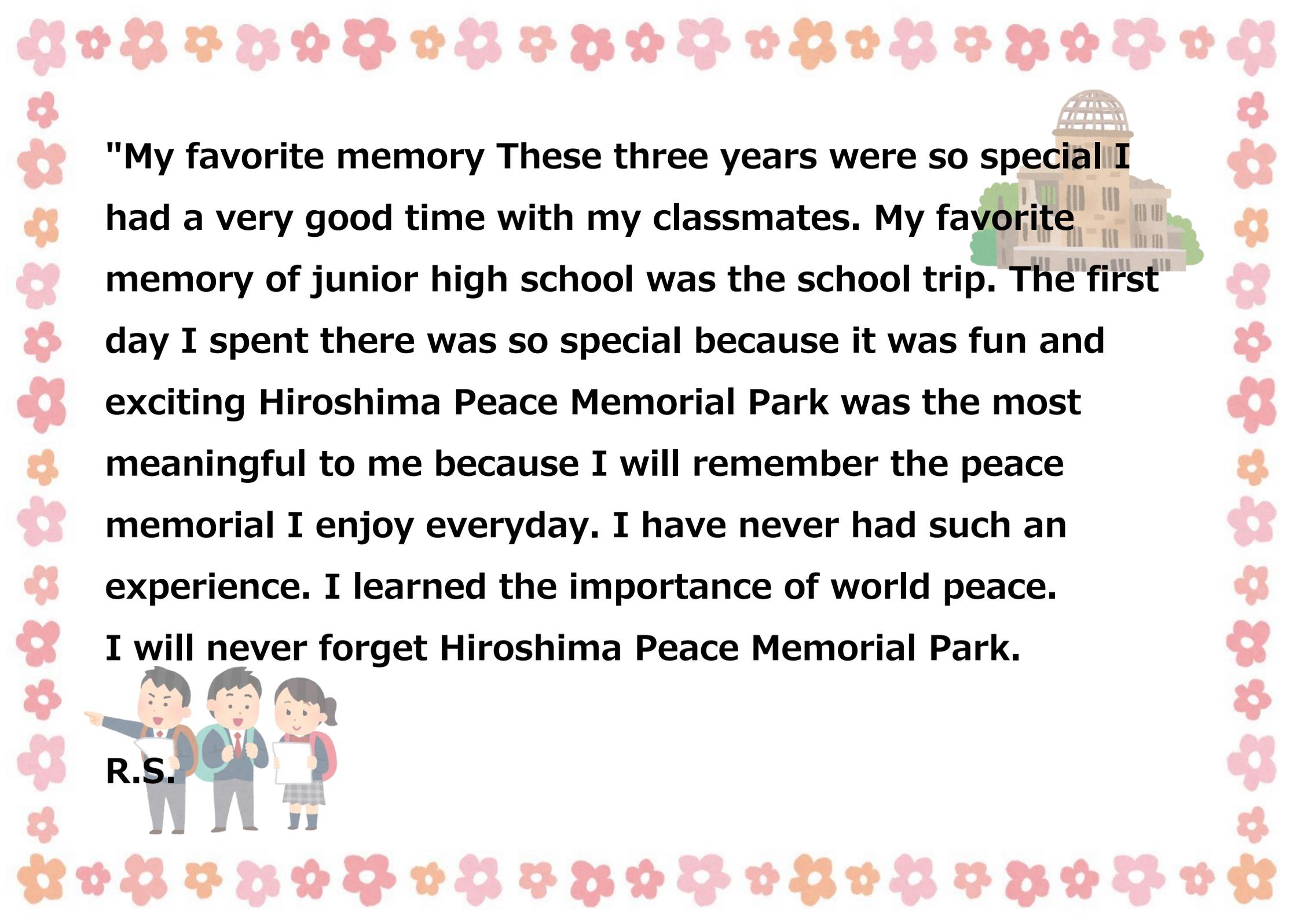




"Sports day My favorite memory is sports day. Because we all worked hard at practicing. I gave friend some advice and we practiced outside in the heat. It was fun practicing together.

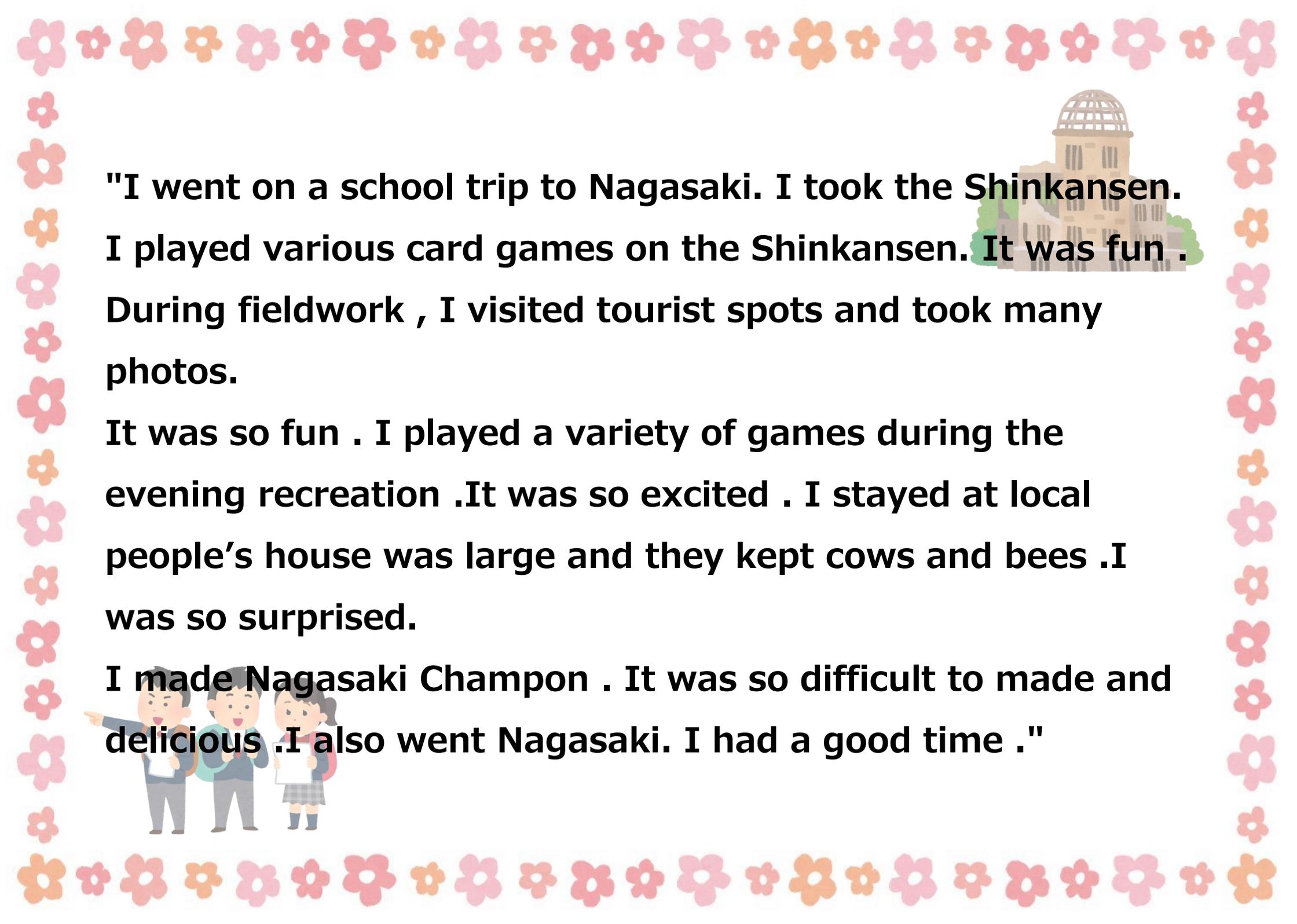
"My best memory of my school trip in junior high school was the homestay and the night recreational stayed with a host family, and they were very kind. I learned about their life and culture.

I made Nagasaki Champon . It was so difficult to made and delicious .I also went Nagasaki. I had a good time ."



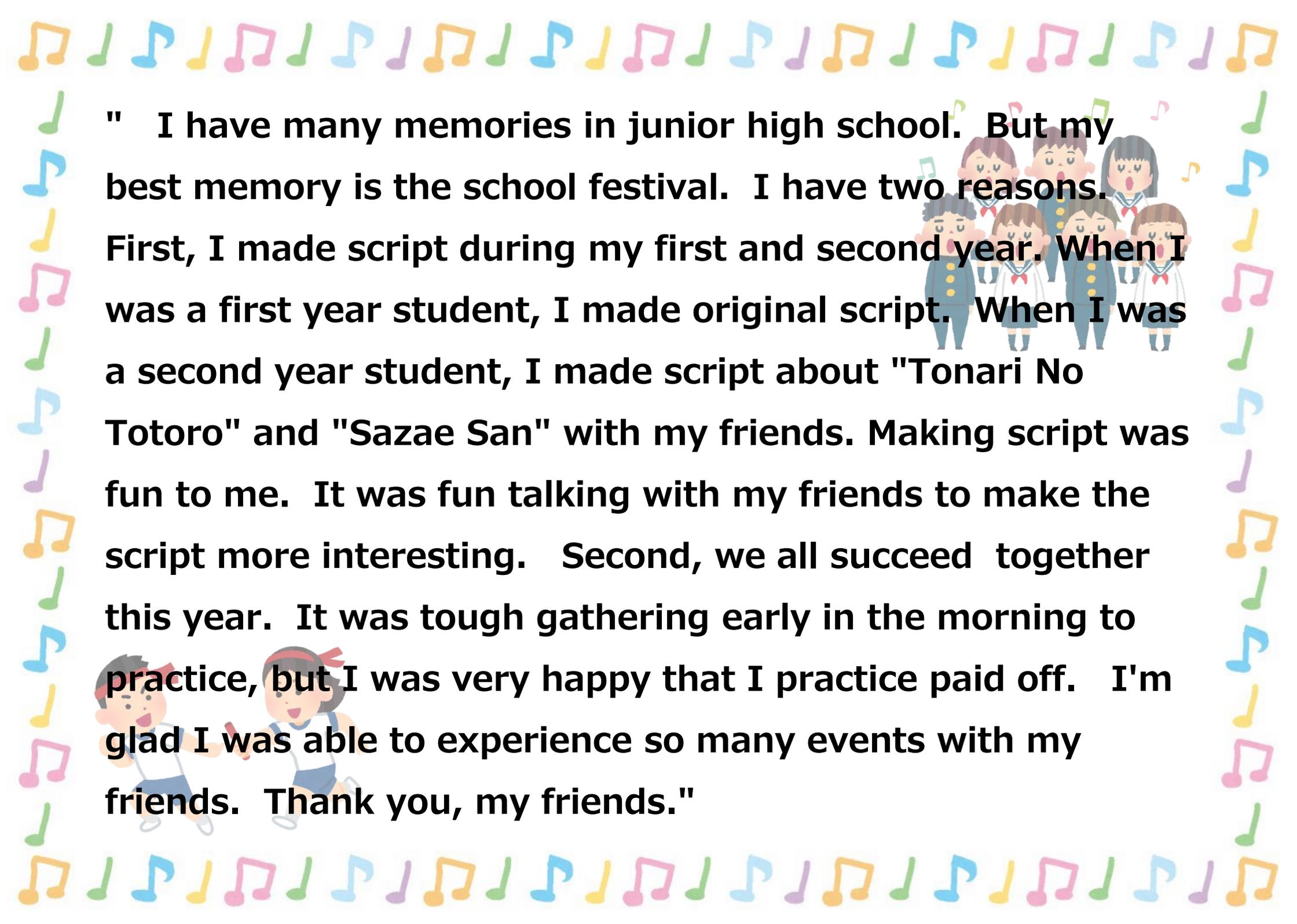

time."

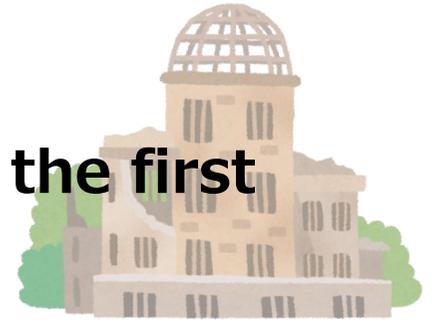
